



Repeat dispensing services

As part of an NHS service your MedicX Pharmacy team can help to manage your prescriptions for you. Allowing you to visit the pharmacy and collect your medicines on a regular basis without the need to visit the surgery on each occasion.

If your GP identifies your condition and medication regime as stable you may be eligible for this service. It is important to note that you cannot choose to use this service. Your GP will choose for you.

We would be glad to provide this service to you giving you the benefit of regular contact with your pharmacist to discuss your medication, simplicity when accessing your medicines and saving you time.

...access your medicines?

- Your GP will assess all patients over a period of time for their suitability to use the repeat dispensing service.
- If your GP feels that you are suitable they will contact you to discuss the service with you and ask you if you want to benefit from it.
- If you decide to use the service your GP will produce a 'batch' of prescriptions for you when your next prescription is due. This will include a 'repeatable prescription' and a number of 'batch prescriptions'. Each batch prescription should supply a months worth of your medication. So if your GP decides that he/she wants to review your medication every three months, you are likely to receive three batch prescriptions. If he/she wants to review your medication every six months you are likely to receive six batch prescriptions.
- When you have received your batch prescriptions take them to your pharmacy and hand them in as normal.
- The pharmacy will then dispense your first batch prescription. Legally they must then keep the repeatable prescription in the pharmacy, but you can choose whether you want to leave the remaining batch prescriptions there too or take them home with you.
- When you next need your medication you visit your pharmacy and hand in your batch prescription if you took it home or ask for your next supply if you didn't. The pharmacy will then supply your medication.
- MedicX Pharmacy will give you a small card with your details on to keep and hand in whenever you visit our pharmacy to request your next supply of medication so that we can provide a high standard of patient service.
